

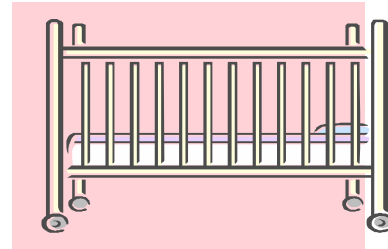


Some advice for a more attentive care to sick children in order to reduce falls:

- If the parent is required to be absent, leaving the child unattended, even for a short period, remember to raise the sides of the bed (though this is normally required for include the child: es. Children under the age of 6 years, disability, etc.).. If the absence should be extended promptly notify the staff.

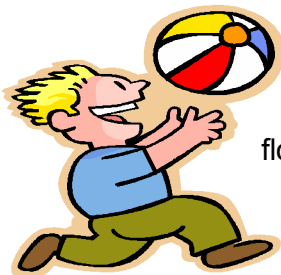


- When you take the baby it is advisable to sit down.



- Never carry a child

from another Unit holding in her arms. if this happens, be sure to wear shoes available, stable, with non-skid soles, and have a clear view in order to avoid accidents such as 'tripping.



- Monitor your child carefully during any environmental cleanup by staff, the wet floor can help prevent falls



- If you need to open the windows, just place them where you can watch them and not leave child unattended

- If u are Using the changing table, use the foresight to place the child with the body in the middle of changing and parallel to the short side and constantly monitor the baby.
- Try to prevent your child run for hospital space, or climb on furniture
